Millbrook, ON – Millbrook MTB is thrilled to announce a new lease agreement for the trails at Jail Hill, located on the rear property of the decommissioned Millbrook Correctional Centre. This exciting development enables Millbrook MTB to officially maintain these popular trails, continuing their mission of building, maintaining, and riding quality mountain biking trails for the Millbrook community.

Trail Access and Opening

Trail Improvements

Dedicated volunteers and Trail Maintenance Coordinators have been working hard to improve the existing single-track trails at Jail Hill, adhering to Whistler Trail Standards. New signage will help distinguish between the main loop and single-track trails for all users. While the trails are designed for mountain biking, they remain open to everyone, and cyclists are expected to yield to pedestrians and uphill riders.

Parking & Trail Access

Visitors arriving at 706 County Rd. 21 will soon see new signs marking the trail access points.

Maintained Trails at Jail Hill

- Prison Loop (Outer loop) – Green, 1.3 km
- Visiting Hours – Blue, 160 m
- Doin' Time – Blue, 220 m
- Razzle Dazzle – Black, 260 m

Wayfinding signage, similar to the MNR Trout Ponds trails, is being installed.
